**Astoria Parks & Recreation Announces Partial Closure to Cathedral Tree Trail**

ASTORIA OR, August 24: The City of Astoria Public Works Department will be repairing culverts at Cathedral Tree Trail from Monday, August 28th to Thursday, August 31st. The City's Parks Department will need to close the hiking trail from the bottom of Cathedral Tree Trail's entrance at 28th Street and Irving Street, up to Cathedral Tree until the project's completion.

Public Works will be working on the culverts to ensure that drainage along the municipal water line beneath the trail is not causing erosion or damage to the line that could result in water delivery disruptions.

Hikers will still be able to access the trail from the Astoria Column to the Cathedral Tree, but will not be able to access the lower portion of the trail past that point. The City of Astoria will be installing signage at the trailhead at the Astoria Column, Cathedral Tree, and at the lower trailhead entrance.

The Parks Department Maintenance crew will be updating residents on Facebook and on the Department's webpage upon completion of the project.
